

or indirectly, lodge any opposition to Plaintiffs' trademark registrations in the future.

9. Defendants agree to entry of this Settlement Agreement as a Consent Order of the Court. It is agreed that the Court shall retain continuing jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this Agreement.

10. Defendants may not show non-ISSR registered dogs as Shiloh Shepherd™ dogs. Notwithstanding this, it is agreed that the Defendants may engage in professional "handling" of ISSR registered Shiloh Shepherd™ dogs. "Handling" is defined exclusively as exhibiting for a fee a dog, not owned directly or indirectly by any Defendant, in a competition or exhibition organized by any club. "Handling" of a duly, currently ISSR registered Shiloh Shepherd™ as a Shiloh Shepherd™ is permitted.

11. In addition to any other remedy provided by law, it is agreed that any violation of this Order may form the basis for an application to the Court for relief. Upon the Court's finding of a violation hereof, it is agreed that Plaintiffs shall be entitled to liquidated damages of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) per violation; Plaintiffs may also seek and obtain reasonable counsel fees and costs incurred with enforcing the terms of this Agreement.

12. The parties release, remise and acquit each other for their respective acts and omissions through the date of execution hereof, except those obligations set forth herein.
